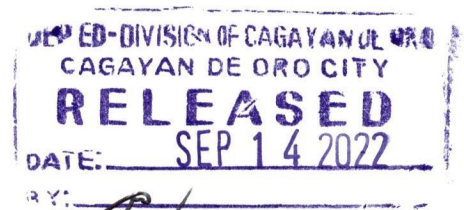

WINS MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE ON INFECTION  
PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) IN SCHOOLS

The Department of Education (DepEd) Bureau of Learner Support Services- School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in collaboration with Deutsche Gesellschaft fur Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), through its Regional Fit for School Programme, Hygiene, and Behavior Change Coalition (HBCC), and Stockholm International Water Institute (SIWI), will conduct a WinS Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on Infection Prevention and Control in School on September 5-17, 2022.
2. The online course is designed for the school personnel to help them understand IPC, its importance for the school setting, and how to implement IPC measures. The course further highlights the role of health and hygiene measures in schools as part of their preparedness and response strategies, thereby creating an even greater demand to capacitate the school personnel on infection prevention and control (IPC). 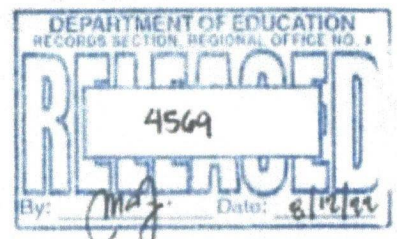

**WinS MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE (MOOC) ON INFECTION  
PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) IN SCHOOLS**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in collaboration with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), through its Regional Fit for School Programme, Hygiene, and Behavior Change Coalition (HBCC), and Stockholm International Water Institute (SIWI), will conduct **WinS Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on Infection Prevention and Control in School** on September 5-17.
2. The online course is designed for the school personnel to help them understand IPC, its importance for the school setting, and how to implement IPC measures. The course further highlights the role of health and hygiene measures in schools as part of their preparedness and response strategies, thereby creating an even greater demand to capacitate the school personnel on infection prevention and control (IPC). The content of this IPC MOOC is in accordance with and in support of DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020 or *Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools*.
3. Hence, this Office requires all elementary and secondary schools to register and participate in this MOOC. Each school can send two participants: a school head and one teacher either assigned as school WinS coordinator, school clinic teacher, teacher managing screening area, or sanitation and waste management coordinator. The course is designed as a four-six-hour course, and the participants are given two weeks to complete the course. The course completers will receive a Certificate of Completion signed by DepEd and its international partners SIWI and GIZ. Enrollment for Mindanao cluster will be on **September 1**.



## How to Enroll in the Course

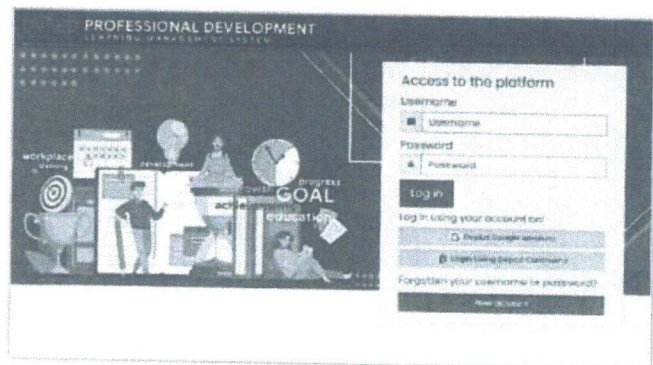
Welcome to the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on **INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) in SCHOOLS**. This course aims to help school heads, teachers, and school personnel to better understand the topic of Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) in schools, its relevance to school operations, and the implementation of IPC measures. The course will also explore the connection between Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) and IPC, as part of the Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OK sa DepEd) program. IPC in schools has gained particular relevance in the recent COVID-19 pandemic, which underlined the role of health and hygiene measures.

Following is the step-by-step guide on how to enroll in the course.

To enroll in the course, you need to have an account in the DepEd's Professional Development LMS, a Training System for Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel.
