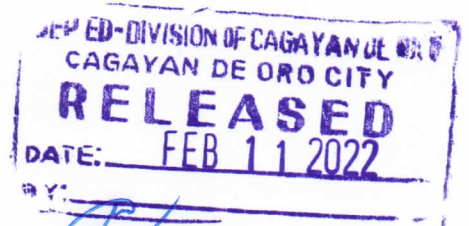

4. Widest dissemination of this advisory is desired.

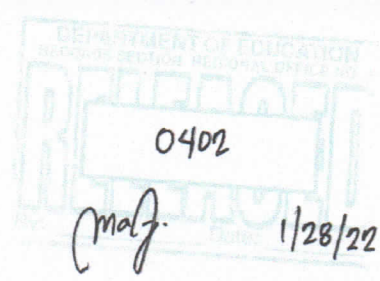


The UP Geology Majors' Society (UP GeMS) will be hosting the annual **Geology Summit** in celebration of its 47th Founding Anniversary.

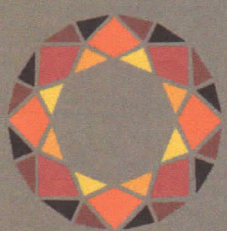
| THE EVENT
