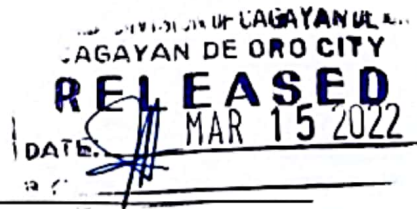

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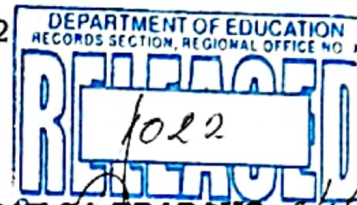

**LAUNCHING OF THE MASHSIGABONG TAGUMPAY SA TRABAHO  
 AT NEGOSYO PINANDAY: THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL  
 GRADUATE SUCCESS STORIES**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in collaboration with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), has performed the National Tracer Study for SY 2017-2018 SHS Graduates. The survey found that 10 percent of the graduates were employed, with 7 percent coming from SHS TVL and 3 percent from the Academic track. Almost 83 percent of the participants in the study were in higher education while only one percent were engaged in entrepreneurship.

2. As the Department continues to promote various SHS exits, the Office of the Undersecretary for the Curriculum and Instruction (OUCI), through BCD, will launch the **Mashsigabong Tagumpay sa Trabaho at Negosyo Pinanday: The SHS Graduates Success Stories** on March 6 and feature the success stories of the graduates through individual videos and narratives on the DepEd's official Web site - DepEd Philippines YouTube Channel, DepEd Philippines Facebook Page, and other official social media platforms from March 17 to April 8.


3. The activity aims to
- showcase success stories of graduates who are gainfully employed and excelling in entrepreneurship as exits of the SHS Program,
  - advocate the SHS program and the road to success,
  - inspire the SHS students and graduates to be successful in their respective SHS exits,
  - promote collaboration among internal and external stakeholders for the success of the SHS Graduates, and
  - gain support from communities and industries in duplicating the success among SHS graduates

4. These success stories of SHS have four categories:  
Category 1: SHS TVL graduates who are gainfully employed  
Category 2: SHS TVL graduates who are entrepreneurs  
Category 1: SHS Academic, Arts, and Design, or Sports graduates who are gainfully employed  
Category 1: SHS Academic, Arts, and Design, or Sports graduates who are entrepreneurs
5. The following are the criteria used for the selection of the SHS Graduate Success Stories:
  - a. The two (2) success stories must come from the batches of SHS graduates.
  - b. The two (2) graduates must have exhibited good moral character and must not have been charged with any administrative, civil, or criminal case.
  - c. The success stories are exemplary and worth emulating and inspiring.
6. Hence, all divisional SHS coordinators, SHS principals, teachers, graduates, and students shall watch the launching and feature program of the SHS graduate success stories.
