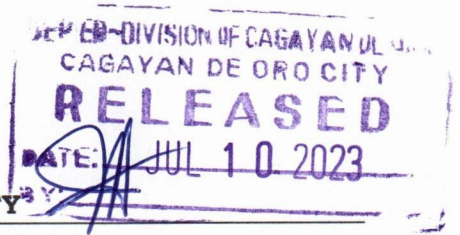

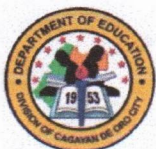
TECHNOLOGY IN TRANSFORMATIVE TIMES

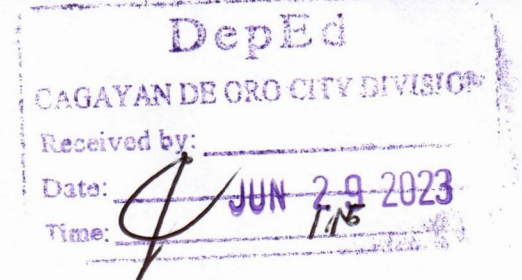
