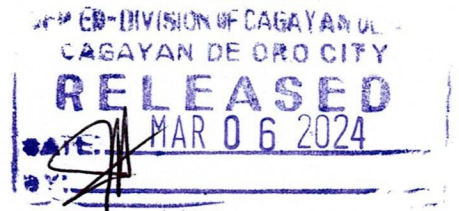

The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resource-10 would like to inform you about the upcoming Fisheries Scholarship Program (FSP) campaign organized by our office. The purpose of this initiative is to prepare students for the National Qualifying Examination, tentatively scheduled on October 19, 2024. These students are categorized into :

- A. FSP-Fisheries Industry Leader Grant (FILG) – Any Senior High School students who have been demonstrated excellence and belong to the Honor Students
- B. FSP-Fisherfolk Children Educational Grant (FCEG) – High school graduate students whose parents are registered Fisherfolk
- C. FSP-Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous People – High school graduate students whose parents belong to Tribal Group registered by the National Commission on Indigenous People.


For CY 2024, we are offering a total of twenty-six (26) slots distributed among three (3) components, namely FILG – 3, FCEG -20 and ICC-IP -3.
