2. Must attend a JCI Manila TOGA training
3. At least 3 years of teaching (consecutive years)
4. Must be licensed to teach with a valid PRD ID
5. Submit a short description of yourself (300 words maximum)
Self-endorsement is allowed
6. Submit 3 testimonials, one testimonial for each of the following:
student, co-worker, and parent
7. No pending and/ or past administrative/ civil/ criminal case
8. Valid employee ID

Additional Requirements:

1. Submit application form (Google Form link given during training)
2. Updated resume
3. NBI clearance (upon passing of screening evaluation)
4. Filipino citizen
5. Residing in the Philippines
